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
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Fall is a special time of the year. For most, Halloween is a favorite celebration. To celebrate, we would like to share some fun and exciting activities for you and your children to do together.

INGREDIENTS

3 Bananas
5 Celery Sticks
2 Green Apples
Strawberries
4 Mandarin Oranges
1/4 Cup peanut butter
1/4 Cup of yogurt
Sunflower seeds
Skewers
Your choice of
Halloween candy

DIRECTIONS: HELP GUIDE YOUR CHILD'S CREATIVITY TO ASSEMBLE THE INDIVIDUAL SNACK TRAY COMPONENTS AND THEN PLACE THEM ON A LARGE PLATTER

STAINED GLASS PUMPKINS

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

 12-15 INCH SQUARE OF WAXED PAPER - 1 PER CHILD
 2-3 INCH PIECES OF TISSUE PAPER
 LIQUID STARCH OR LIQUID ELMER'S GLUE
 PAINT BRUSHES
 SMALL BOWL OF WATER

•SCISORS

OPTIONAL MATERIALSBLACK CONSTRUCTION PAPER
BLACK MARKERS



DIRECTIONS:

1: HAVE YOUR CHILD PLACE A TISSUE PAPER SQUARE ONTO THE WAX PAPER -YOU MAY NEED TO TAPE THE WAX PAPER DOWN ONTO THE TABLE SO THAT IT WON'T MOVE


2: LET YOUR CHILD PAINT OVER THE TISSUE PAPER SQUARE WITH EITHER WATERED DOWN LIQUID STARCH OR WATERED DOWN GLUE

3: HAVE YOUR CHILD CONTINUE ADDING THE TISSUE SQUARES UNTIL THEIR DESIGN IS COMPLETE OR THE WAX PAPER IS FULL

4: WHEN THE STARCH OR GLUE HAS DRIED UP, HELP THE CHILDREN CUT THEIR PAPER INTO THE SHAPE OF A PUMPKIN

5: OPTIONAL - EITHER HELP YOUR CHILD CUT BLACK PAPER INTO SHAPES OF EYES AND A MOUTH FOR THE PUMPKIN OR USE A MARKER TO HELP THEM DRAW EYES AND A MOUTH

6: TAPE THE PUMPKIN TO A WINDOW TO SEE THE STAINED GLASS EFFECT!
